TYPE OF PLOT	ANNUAL FEE
Standard Plot Size	<b>£40.00</b>
Half Plot Size	<b>£20.00</b>
Three Quarter Plot Size	<b>£30.00</b>
One & Half Plot Size	<b>£60.00</b>
Double Plot Size	<b>£80.00</b>

Details of individual cost will be posted or emailed to the addresses which we have on record and hence we would encourage all allotment tenants to ensure that their details are up to date by emailing them to [clerk@great-ayton.org.uk](mailto:clerk@great-ayton.org.uk)
